

THIRD PARTY TERMS

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These Third Party Terms are current from 1 July 2026

General

In addition to the General Terms and any applicable Product Terms, these Third Party Terms apply to any InfoTrack Products identified in these terms that You access or order from InfoTrack or an InfoTrack Reseller, where:

General Terms means either:

- (a) the terms of any Master Services Agreement (including any applicable Order Form) or similar between InfoTrack and the Client (**MSA**); or

Product Terms means the product specific terms that are applicable to any InfoTrack Products in addition to the General Terms, as set out in this document and available at <https://www.infotrack.com/hubfs/Legal%20terms/Product%20Terms.pdf>.

Third Party Terms means these terms, conditions, restraints, disclaimers or limitations (as required by InfoTrack's Third Party Suppliers) applicable to certain InfoTrack Products that are provided or licensed by Third Party Suppliers to InfoTrack, located here [www.infotrack.com/hubfs/Legal%20terms/Inwww.inffoTrack-Third-Party-Terms-US%20\(1\).pdf](http://www.infotrack.com/hubfs/Legal%20terms/Inwww.inffoTrack-Third-Party-Terms-US%20(1).pdf) and as updated by InfoTrack from time to time.

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PART A DocketSync Orders

You agree that, in addition to the General Terms and any applicable Product Terms, the following Third Party Terms apply to your use of any Tyler Case Alerts by placing a DocketSync order.

A1 DocketSync Orders

A1.1 All DocketSync orders are subject to the following disclaimers:

- (a) The User acknowledges that the User will not:
 - (i) Transfer or assign the User's license to Tyler Case Alert Integration to a third party, except in connection with a corporate reorganization or corporate transaction involving the User;
 - (ii) Reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Tyler Case Alert Integration
 - (iii) Rent, lease, lend, or provide commercial hosting services with the Tyler Case Alert Integration
 - (iv) Publish or otherwise disclose the Tyler Case Alert Integration or related documents to third parties.
- (b) The User also acknowledges that:
 - (i) The license to use the Tyler Case Alert Integration is for the User's business purposes only;
 - (ii) Tyler owns the title, copyright, and other intellectual property rights in the Tyler Case Alert Integration and documentation.
 - (iii) The Tyler Case Alert Integration is licensed, not sold
 - (iv) The User may make copies of the Tyler Case Alert Integration for backup and testing purposes, so long as such copies are not used in production and the testing is for internal use only;
 - (v) The User shall not export, directly or indirectly, the Tyler Case Alert Integration to any country to which the United States government or agency thereof at the time of export requires an export license or other governmental approval without first obtaining such license or approval;
 - (vi) All warranties and conditions, whether express, implied, or statutory, including but not limited to, any implied warranties, duties or condition of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose are disclaimed
 - (vii) To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, in no event shall Tyler be liable for any special, incidental, or consequential damages whatsoever, even if Tyler has been advised of the possibility of such damages.
